LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS TO HOST OXFORD CANDIDATE FORUM

The League of Women Voters of the Mid-Shore (LWVMS), in partnership with the Town of Oxford and the Oxford Community Center, will sponsor a forum for candidates competing in the election to fill the expired term of one Town of Oxford Commissioner for a three-year term of office.

The forum will take place on June 9 from 5:30pm to 7:00pm at the Oxford Community Center, 200 Oxford Road in Oxford, MD.

The following candidates, who have registered as required by the Oxford Board of Supervisors of Election, have been invited to attend:

- Tom Costigan
- David Donovan

Per the Town of Oxford Charter, candidates may qualify with the Town of Oxford Board of Election Supervisors as a “write in candidate” by June 7, 2025. Candidates who qualify as a “write-in candidate” by the deadline will also be invited to participate in the forum.

The forum will be moderated by LWVMS President Glenna Heckathorn. Questions will be submitted from the audience via notecards distributed during the forum. All candidates will be asked the same questions and will have equal time to respond.
